Sheboygan Area Youth Soccer Organization Code of Conduct

The Sheboygan Area Youth Soccer Organization was established to promote the game of soccer and to provide an atmosphere in which the game can be learned and enjoyed. To this end the Board of Directors has created the Uniform Code of Conduct. All players, coaches, and parents of all recreational clubs are required to abide by this code.

Players are expected to conduct themselves in a sporting like manner at all times while participating in SAYSO events. Opposing players and coaches, as well as referees should be treated with respect. Our objective at all times is a recreational game played in a sporting like manner. All participants must support this goal if it is to be attained.

Coaches, including assistant coaches, are charged with the responsibility of controlling their players, **parents**, and themselves at all times during the game. Continual chiding of referees, failure to maintain order on the touchlines, failure to control his or her players, or willful violation of any league rules are unacceptable. Coaches who continually disrupt the game will be expected to leave the sideline for the remainder of the game. The game may be ended at the discretion of the referee.

Parents can be a very positive influence on the game of soccer and are encouraged to attend as many games as possible to support their children. Just as a **parent** can be a positive and encouraging presence, he or she can also be a negative influence. **Parents** who are disruptive and disrespectful to referees, other parents, players or coaches cannot be tolerated. Coaches will be asked to control disruptive **parents**. If the situation does not improve, the referee has the right to end the game.

Current FIFA Rules apply with special emphasis on the following:

Misconduct: As defined in the laws of soccer misconduct may be of two kinds: misconduct resulting in a caution, and misconduct resulting in ejection.

Caution (indicated by referee raising a yellow card):

A player may be cautioned for:

- 1) Illegal substitution - entering the field of play without the referee's permission.
- 2) Persistent breaking of the rules.
- 3) Dissent, that is, arguing with the referee.
- 4) Unsporting like conduct, that is, deliberately interfering with the referee's control of the game by such means as purposely delaying the game, insulting behavior, or particularly hard fouls.

Ejection (indicated by referee raising a red card):

A referee should automatically eject a player for:

- 1) Violent behavior, such as spitting, striking, or maliciously kicking another player.
- 2) Foul behavior or abusive language.
- 3) Persisting in misconduct after receiving a caution. A player cannot be cautioned twice in the same game. The second caution must result in ejection.

The SAYSO-Sheboygan Division Board of Directors reserves the right to remove any player from further participation when said player or his/her parent/guardian acts in any way that is detrimental to the safety of others or the enjoyment of the game.

- ❖ **New Players:** Completed registration form and payment should be returned to SAYSO c/o Community Recreation Department, 607 S. Water St., Sheboygan, WI 53081.
Returning Players: All returning players should turn in their form and fee to their coach.
- ❖ **Fee covers both Fall 2011 & Spring 2012 League.** Play begins early Sept. & mid-April.
- ❖ Players who withdraw prior to October 1 for any reason shall be assessed a \$10.00 service fee. NO REFUNDS of any amount will be given after October 1.
- ❖ **Players MUST wear shin guards.** Soccer shoes and ball are recommended.
- ❖ **Players cannot be rostered on two teams concurrently, select or recreational.**
- ❖ Age groups will be combined if there is not sufficient enrollment. **The Board of Directors reserves the right to place a player in an appropriate age bracket based on skill level and interest.**

If you are a returning player and wish to play on the same team, your coach is collecting and turning in a completed team roster including player registration forms and fees by June 4. **Turn in your registration form and fee to your coach!** If you register individually at the Rec. Dept. by June 3, you need to make sure your name is included on your teams' roster (tell coach). **Communicate with your coach!** Player(s) not indicated on a team roster at the registration deadline may not necessarily be placed on their team of choice. If you are a returning player and wish to play on a different team, you need to communicate with the coach of the team you want to play on and be included on that teams' roster.
